RULES FOR THE DECEMBER CASH AWARDS SHOW: One painting per member may be entered in the December Show. Maximum size for entries must not exceed 48 inches in height or width, including the frame. Original work only. Copies of existing artwork, class work, or previous SDAG Art Show winners are not allowed in this competition. Artists must include 1) Artist's name, 2) Title of work, 3) Medium used, and 4) Price, on the back of each entry. All paintings must be framed with the exception of oil or acrylic works done on stapled canvas. All canvas pieces must be stapled on the back of the frame, not on the sides where it is visible. All works must have multistrand wire, which when hung is slack enough to come 2-3 inches from the top of painting. Plexiglass should be used in lieu of glass for framed works 22 x 24 inches, or larger. Works done with pastels are exempted from the plexiglass requirement. Entry fees will be \$7.00 per entry for work under 36 inches in height or width, and \$10.00 for entries 36 inches and larger (dimensions include the frame). Note: The Art Committee has the right to refuse any entry not conforming to these standards.

RULES FOR THE DECEMBER CASH AWARDS SHOW: One painting per member may be entered in the December Show. Maximum size for entries must not exceed 48 inches in height or width, including the frame. Original work only. Copies of existing artwork, class work, or previous SDAG Art Show winners are not allowed in the competition. Artists must include 1) Artist's name, 2) Title of work, 3) Medium used, and 4) Price, on the back of each entry. All paintings must be framed with the exception of oil or acrylic works done on staples canvas. All canvas pieces must be stapled on the back of the frame, not on the sides where it is visible. All works must have multistrand wire, which when hung is slack enough to come 2-3 inches from the top of paintings. Plexiglass should be used in lieu of glass for framed works 22 x 24 inches, or larger. Works done with pastels are exempted from the plexiglass requirement. Entry fees will be \$7.00 per entry for work under 26 inches in height or width, and \$10.00 for entries 36 inches and larger (dimensions include the frame). Note: The Art Committee has the right to refuse any entry not conforming to these standards.






