







Garden tours, art and a Mother's Day Tea have been planned this weekend by Quail Botanical Gardens and the San Dieguito Art Guild. This annual event is held at both the gardens and Offtrack Gallery (home of the Art Guild).

Docent-led tours through the gardens will be held at 10 a.m., 11 a.m., 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. Spring flowers, flowering vines, tropical palms and succulents are among the flora on display.

Art lovers also can view the works of more than 50 local artists at the Offtrack Gallery. On Sunday, people can take a self-guided tour through any or all of the 10 North County artists' homes to gain a more personal glimpse of their studios and gardens.

A Mother's Day Tea with scones, finger sandwiches and desserts will be held in the Walled Garden at the botanical gardens. Reservations are required for the Sunday tea, which begins at 2:30 p.m.

One such structure Breslaw employs resembles a kind of other or stage. Gestural bands of color echo the edges of the painting, forming a central "window", which may itself be further divided. Within this space is found either a series of circles or squares, which are themselves full of whitting or compacted energy. Like a reliquory, Breslaw's visual repositories afford a glimpse at a measured mystery.

A second organizing structure for Breslow's paintings is a series of blocky forms, created from vigorous brushstrakes. These rectangles, jostling and dissolving in indeterminate space, seem to recall the encounters which objects and personalities experience in the real world.

A find structure is a kind of wave or flame that begins to break apart at its extremities. Here gesture is macrocasmic, giving form to a large figural presence. As in all of Breslaw's paintings, high keyed color cames much of the visual diames. Gesture becomes coloristic handwriting, aspiring toward a sort of controlled delinium.

In Breslaw's mixed media pointings, one is opt to find snippets of actual writing, textural passages, and collaged elements. The latter are often photographic patterns derived from nature or technology, providing another layer of snalty to the immediacy of the artist's gestural approach. While the patterns may depict actual examples of land and water, they remind us that Breslaw is constantly alluding to the natural world in her work. There are symbolic representations of sun-like disks and glowing spirals, merging with a matrix of flow and dissolution. There is, as well, a sense of radiance and barely controlled vitality. The artist contends with all these energies as equally natural and human phenomena.






