Information/Changes For Wall Renters

Due to the increase in number of entries in the Monthly Show and to a prior calculation in size of wall space devoted to each artist that incorrectly included the moldings in the calculation, the Board of Directors voted that the amount of space allowed for half Wall Renters be changed to 12.75 sq. ft. or 30” x 62” and for Full Wall Renters to 25 sq. ft. or 60 x 60. 7. All artwork must be original. No reproductions.
8. All Artwork must be For Sale.
9. Artwork should be less than two years old and not previously entered in a SDAG Monthly Show.
10. Artwork must be labeled (on back) with: Artist's name, Title, Category (see rule 11 below), Medium and Price. Please prepare two labels (available on the back page of the "Paint Rag").
11. Normal categories include: Oil & Acrylic, Water Media (includes acrylic under glass), Photography, Wood Block prints, etchings, and monoprints hand pulled by the artist, and Other Media. Any media with at least five entries will create an additional category.
12. It is up to the Artist to place their work in the proper category. Incorrectly categorized work may be ineligible for judging.

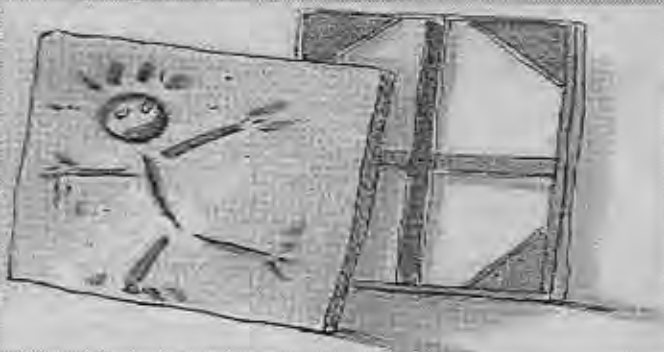
