

San Dieguito Art Guild (SDAG) was founded over thirty years ago as a non-profit organization dedicated to furthering artistic understanding in the local community. SDAG is also dedicated to fostering the artistic growth of indi vidual members through social and eductional events. Six years ago we moved to the Off Track Gallery, where we enjoy an excellent relationship with the Pannikin Restaurant. Together we share the Old Santa Fe Train Station, an important local landmark of historical importance.

Location, Hours, and Exhibits

The Old Sante Fe Train Station is located at 510 N. Highway 101, between Encinitas Blvd. and Leucadia Blvd. The gallery is open daily from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and is closed only on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, and Easter Sunday. The Off Track Gallery has an ever changing exhibit of art by over 200 local artists. This format is achieved in several different ways. SDAG has monthly membership shows, which are judged by San Diego area professional artists. Each month a different guild member is featured as Artist of the Month, and 35 to 40 members show work upstairs and downstairs on an ongoing basis. This adds up to a display of over 250 works of art in our gallery at any given time. Because our painters, photographers, potters, jewelers, and glass artists are local, many customers find that our artist-set prices are extremely reasonable.

Considering that many of our artists are published, collected and have won show awards, the customer is indeed lucky to find us.

Membership

Membership is \$40 annually per person and \$55 per couple, for two artists within the same family. A student membership of \$15 is currently available for artists ages 15 to 18. Dues are payable by September 30 of each year. A "Lifetime" membership has been established an honorary gift to thank extraordinary individuals who have given many years of service. Two members, Vada Kimble and Betty Sturdevan, have earned this honor. As a member you are required to devote time to the guild in one or more ways. You may be required to work on a project, a committee or in the gallery as a sitter. Once you have paid your membership, please contact the job coordinator.

Membership Show Regulations

All members may submit one piece of original art to the monthly membership show. The gallery committee has the right to refuse any entry that fails to meet guild standards. Frames must have multi-strand wire for hanging. Plexiglass or equivalent must be used on frames larger than 22" x 24"; pastels excluded. Maximum entry size is 48" on any side including frame. The monthly show is judged by a professional artist who awards ribbons in Water Media (watercolor and acrylics under glass), Oil/Acrylic Media, and other media categories. If there are five or more entries in any given media category it becomes a separate award category.
