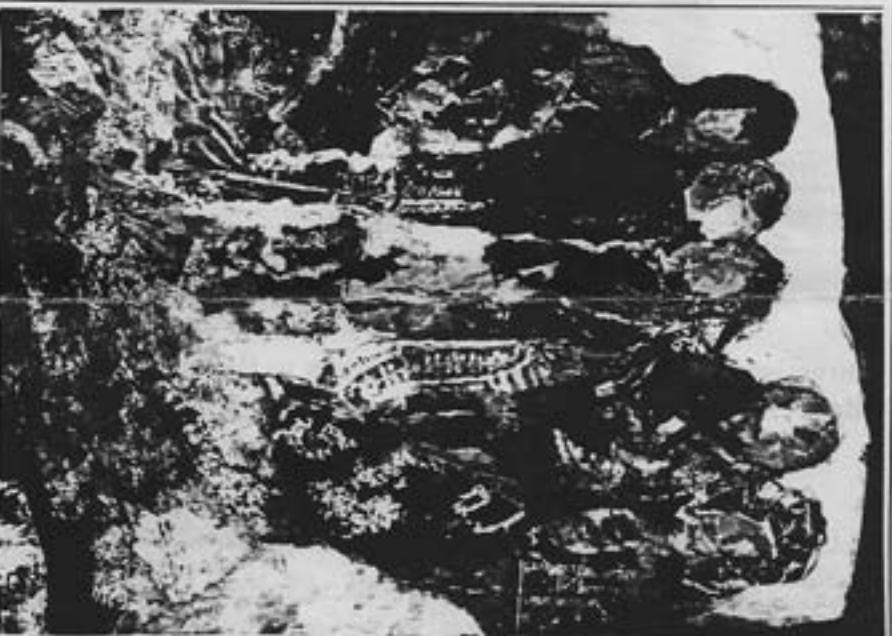

1. Fees: \$10 up and including 36" \$15 over 36" to maximum of 48."
 2. Maximum size in any direction is 48"
 3. 15% commission on sales.
 4. No glass in frames larger than 22" x 24." Use plexiglass or equivalent. (Pastels excluded.)
 5. Paintings must be framed. Oil or acrylic on wrap-around canvas excepted.
 6. Frames must have multi-strand wire, hanging 2-3" from top w/ ends of wire taped.
 7. All artwork must be original.
 8. All artwork must be for sale.
 9. Artwork should be less than 2 years old and not previously entered in our monthly show.
 10. Label artwork on back using 2 labels provided in The Paint Rag.
 11. Categories include: Oil & Acrylic, Water Media, includes Acrylic under glass, Photography, Wood Block Prints, Etchings, Monoprints, hand-pulled by artist and Other Media. Any media with at least five (5) entries will be considered an additional category.
 12. Artist's entry must be in appropriate category or may be ineligible for judging.
- *SDAG Art Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry not conforming to above rules & standards.
