6. Frames must have multi-strand wire, hanging 2-3" from top with ends of wire taped.
7. All artwork must be original.
8. All artwork must be for sale.
9. Artwork should be less than 2 years old and not previously entered in our monthly show.
10. Label artwork on back using 2 labels provided in The Paint Rag.
11. Categories include: Oil & Acrylic, Water Media, includes Acrylic under glass, Photography, Wood Block Prints, Etchings, Monoprints, hand-pulled by artist and Other Media. Any media with at least five (5) entries will be considered an additional category.
12. Artist's entry must be in appropriate category or may be ineligible for judging.

While trees become more vibrant in autumn, grasses tend to wilt, dry up and become muted and softer looking. The ground cover is often made up of various shades of brown, sepia, ochre and pale yellow, which provide yet another great back-drop for the warmer colors. When considering shifts in color temperature, remember that even the intense yellows, oranges and reds lose their vibrancy and become muted and softer the farther they recede into the distance space.


