## History

The San Dieguito Art Guild (SDAG) was founded in 1965 as a non-profit organization dedicated to furthering artistic understanding in the local community. SDAG is also dedicated to fostering the artistic growth of individual members through social and eductional events. In 1994 we moved to the Off Track Gallery, where we enjoy an excellent relationship with the Pannikin Restaurant. Together we share the Old Santa Fe Train Station, a local landmark of historical importance. In 2001 SDAG became a 501(c)(4) Social Welfare Organization.

### Location, Hours, and Exhibits

The Old Sante Fe Train Station is located at 510 N. Highway 101, between Encinitas Blvd. and Leucadia Blvd. The gallery is open daily from 9 AM to 6 PM and is closed only on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, and Easter Sunday. The Off Track Gallery has an ever changing exhibit of art by over 200 local artists. This format is achieved in several different ways. SDAG has monthly membership shows, which are judged by San Diego area professional artists. Each month a different guild member is featured as Artist of the Month, and 35 to 40 members show work upstairs and downstairs on an ongoing basis. This adds up to a display of over 250 works of art in our gallery at any given time. Because our painters, photographers, potters, jewelers, and gloss artists are local, many customers find that our artist-set prices are extremely reasonable. Considering that many of our artists are published, collected and have won show awards, the customer is indeed lucky to find us.

#### Location, Hours, and Exhibits

The Old Santa Fe Train Station is located at 510 N. Highway 101, between Encinitas Blvd. and Leucadia Blvd. The gallery is open daily from 9 AM to 6 PM and is closed only on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, and Easter Sunday. The Off Track Gallery has an ever changing exhibit of art by over 200 local artists. This format is achieved in several different ways. SDAG has monthly membership shows, which are judged by San Diego area professional artists. Each month a different guild member is featured as Artist of the Month, and 35 to 40 members who work upstairs and downstairs on an ongoing basis. This adds up to a display of over 250 works of art in our gallery at any given time. Because our painters, photographers, potters, jewelers, and glass artists are local, many customers find that our artist-set prices are extremely reasonable. ## Membership

Membership is \$40 annually per person and \$55 per couple for two artists within the same household. A student membership of \$15 is currently available for artists ages 15 through 18. Dues are payable by September 30 of each year. A Lifetime Membership has been established as an honorary gift to thank extraordinary individuals who have given many years of service.

As a member you are expected to devote time to the guild. You may be required to work on a project, a committee or in the gallery as a sitter. Once you have paid your membership, please contact the jobs coordinator.

## Membership Show Regulations

All members may submit one piece of original art to the monthly membership show. The gallery committee has the right to refuse any entry that fails to meet guild standards. Frames must have multi-strand wire for hanging. Plexiglass or equivalent must be used on frames larger than 22" x 24" (pastels excluded). Maximum entry size is 38" along any edge including frame. Fee for artwork under 30" is \$10. Fee for artwork 30" and larger is \$20. There is a 15% commission on sales from the show wall and a 5% charge for credit card sales. The monthly show is judged by a professional artist who will award ribbons by media. If there are are five or more entries in any given media category, it will become a separate award category.

#### Membership

Membership is \$40 annually per person and \$55 per couple for two artists within the same household. A student membership of \$15 is currently available for artists ages 15 through 18. ## Wall and Floor Renters

For members interested in renting wall or floor space, you must first read the rules for Wall/Floor Renters found in the Procedure Book on the gallery desk. After reading them, call the Wall/Floor Renter's Chairman to place your name on the waiting list. Wall and floor renters act as our sales people, and keep the gallery clean. The sitting obligation is three (3) shifts per month for a full wall/floor, and two (2) shifts for a half wall/floor.

## Monthly Newsletter

The Paint Rag is our guild's monthly newsletter, which updates members on past, present and future events, community art news, rules and regulations, and any changes from normal dates and procedures affecting members.

### The Procedure Book

The Procedure Book is kept in the gallery and is a notebook of procedures and forms used by the guild to conduct business. All gallery sitters must familiarize themselves with its contents.

## Parking

We sublet our spoace in the Old Sante Fe Train Station building from the Pannikin Restaurant. Our ability to rent the gallery space depends in part, on the ability of the Pannikin to run a successful business. This requires that a large amount of parking space be available for both the Pannikin and the gallery customers. As a result, we have been asked to NOT use the parking spaces immediately in front and in the back of the station building.

#### Wall and Floor Renters

For members interested in renting wall or floor space, you must first read the rules for Wall/Floor renters found in the Procedure Book on the gallery desk. After reading them, call the Wall/Floor Renters Chairman to place your name on the waiting list. Wall and floor renters act as our sales people, and keep the gallery clean. The sitting obligation is three (3) shifts per month for a full wall/floor, and two (2) shifts for a half wall/floor.

#### Monthly Newsletter

The Paint Rag is our guild's monthly newsletter, which updates members on past, present and future events, community art news, rules and regulations, and any changes from normal dates and affecting members.

#### The Procedure Book

The Procedure Book is kept in the gallery and is a note book for procedures and forms used by the guild to conduct business. All gallery sitters must familiarize themselves with its contents.

#### Parking


