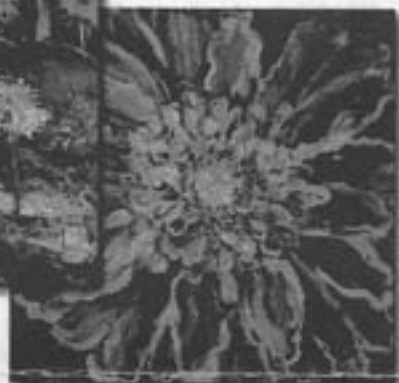

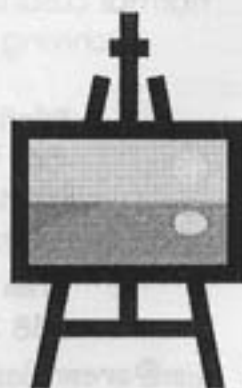

Take yourself back, back to when you were a child, when everything you encountered was for the first time. Remember the excitement and innocence of those experiences- a tree you never saw before, a sea shell at the beach, a lighthouse perched on a hill. No opinions or pre-conceived thoughts of a place, but instead just magic. Imagine living in a world with trees blowing in the wind as if they were hair, colors intense with vibrancy, transformed from the muted colors we so often see in the "progress" of our civilization. Colors alive. Waking down the street becomes an adventure of the senses. This is what I am trying to re-create... the sense of magic in the world that is always there if we just take a

moment to observe it. Most of all, it is capturing the moment.

I was born in the year of '74 in sunny San Diego, California, living in England for a year when I was young. Society told me I could never be a professional artist because the world would not support it. Regardless, I had a couple of great art classes in high school and later decided to enroll myself into an art college in San Francisco for a year. After that, additional classes at a local junior college gave me the experience and drive to be an artist. I continually travel the world to experience different cultures and wildlife, gathering inspiration to express in my paintings. My work has hung in prominent galleries and has been accepted into prestigious art fairs. I sell to zoos nationwide and boast collectors worldwide. Subsequently, I have won national contests and have been published in national magazines. Influences in my work include Van Gogh, Kandinsky, the Fauves, and many others- hence the bright colors and whimsical perspectives.

To keep your colors clean and vibrant, Martha Gilman Roach recommends placing white oil paint in four different areas of your palette. That will provide a separate white to mix with earth tones and the primary colors red, yellow, or blue.
