# Important Message From Your President

The Relocation Committee and several other members who are gladly serving as active advisors to the committee are still looking for a suitable and affordable place for the new gallery. However, even if we found the perfect place today at the right price, we have a very huge financial stumbling block: we need someone or a group who is willing to sign our lease as guarantor(s). We need an "Angel" to help us or we will not be able to get into a new gallery until we raise the money ourselves that would give a prospective landlord assurance that our lease obligations will be met. That could take several years. In the meantime the Guild itself will continue and we are looking for an office space so we have an address and a place in which to run the Guild.

So I have asked the board and I am asking all of you to jump in and help us out. We need to publicize the fact that we are in need of financial backing. At the same time we are still looking for available space. 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

# Hint From the Nov. Judge/ Demonstrator

Michelle Abrams SayS, "Generally, I prefer to approach a painting intuitively. It is fun for me when the painting itself guides me - or takes me along the creative journey. Because I teach the "Basics of Art", those rules are always whispering to me in the back of my mind, i.e. 'What is your design structure? Where are your lost edges? What is your value map?' So, along with those principles. I let go and just paint. I begin with a loose wet into wet - then tighten up with negative painting and finish with tighter detail."

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# An Important Message From Your President

- Relocation of the Gallery: We are still looking at several places. As soon as we have a place we will let everyone know. Have patience and faith!
- 2) **Staying in Encinitas:** Many members have requested that we look at places in Oceanside or Carlsbad because those places do a lot to support the arts, but I would like to see the gallery stay right here in Encinitas. And I am not alone in that. I believe Encinitas is our home. What we need is support from the City Council. We get that by going through the City Arts Commission.

On Monday Nov 1<sup>st</sup> four of us went before the Art Commission with a plea to help direct us in how to get support from the City Council. They were very helpful and now we are developing a PLAN. Cris Weatherby is putting it together, a history of the guild, how we work, our finances, why we want to stay in Encinitas, and what we need from the Council. We are also changing our Mission Statement to reflect more work with the youth in Encinitas, teaching classes, helping them to learn about matting and framing so that they are qualified to serve as interns at a framing business when they graduate, helping them to be knowledgeable about all aspects of art.

Once we get this plan together we will present it to the Arts Commission and they in turn will take it to the City. Then the city must address the plan. We will be asking for financial help as well ask the City's endorsement. I believe this is a good thing because the City wants to keep artists here. I'll keep you posted. Remember...even small government is good at taking a long time to take action on requests!

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teaches all over the county on how to use conservation materials in mats, backing boards, mounting materials, frames and glass. He is a very easy lecturer to listen to. He is full of information. If you sneeze you will miss a whole chapter's worth of techniques! He's fun too. As soon as we have a date for it I would urge you to sign up for the framing workshop. You will not regret it. Even if you do not frame yourself, it is your professional responsibility as an artist to know that you are getting the true archival materials from your framer so that your artwork will not fade or come loose or change color. So you need to know what materials are archival and what are not.

Rob is also interested in helping youngsters learn how to finish a piece of artwork and do it well. So we are talking to him about working together with the guild in doing that too. He is also having a sale of frames and mats at the beginning of the year. His prices will be *very, very* low because he wants to get rid of the things he has. He cannot use them, but a number of us can. So as soon as I hear the date I will let you know. These will be REAL BARGAINS.
