Take-in for August's show is TUES-DAY (when the gallery is closed), July 25 from 9:30am to noon – yes, this is a NEW DAY OF THE WEEK.

If you have already signed up for 3 months in advance for July/August/ September, you don¹t have to bring a check unless you are putting in a piece for the WaveCrest Show (\$10 per piece). Or you may pay month-bymonth at the rate of \$15 per month. If you opted to sign up for the 3-month deal, you may not "roll over" your payment to another month. If you choose not to hang for a month, you forfeit your payment. We are determined to get everyone on the same schedule. We know that there are a very few of you who ended your May/June/July schedule. You will pay for 2 months at the 3-month rate for August/ September so that NOW everyone will be on the same schedule.

The Off Track Gallery HAS the use of the foyer in August and we also have our hallways. The continuing WaveCrest Show has the same rules as last month:

- The price is \$10 per piece of art.
- You may show only one piece in the WaveCrest Show and you must have at least one piece in the "regular" gallery.
- The show will be judged.
- Your piece must be less than 40 inches on the diagonal.
- Your art must be of the theme: classic cars/woody cars, surfing/surfscapes, coastal life/beach town life, ocean, and local landscapes.
- You do not have to sit an extra shift for your WaveCrest piece. Take-in is on the regular day with the rest of the gallery. The only thing new for the month of August only is that the WaveCrest-Show will be open to non-SDAG

members (just like we do for the Small Image Show). If you have friends who are not Guild members and would like to show in the WaveCrest Show, please let them know. The non-member fee is \$20 per piece.

In the unlikely event that you miss your scheduled gallery sitting date you have a choice: You may either pay \$30 for the date missed or make it up by sitting an extra TWO shifts in the future. You need to call or e-mail either June Clark or Harriet Shoup to make these arrangements. Your "debt" will have to be cleared before you will be allowed into the next show.

Please note that if you are submitting a reproduction made from your original painting or drawing, your art will not be in the monthly judging and will not be eligible to receive a ribbon. Your art (this includes shrink-wraps) must be clearly marked as a reproduction/print/Gicleé so our customers will not be mislead.

- The entire gallery changes every month. If you had art in the July show you need to bring in a replacement (even if you pre-paid for 3 months). Take-in day is Tue. July 25, 2006, NOTE NEW DAY 9:30am-Noon.
- Each artist is limited to 3 pieces of wall art in the "regular" (non-WaveCrest) gallery. However, you must sit 3 times in August – one for each piece of art. - Your art from the month of July will still be tranging on the wall Leave it there until you are all finished with the take-in paper work. Pick up your art just before you plan to leave the building.
