Entry Fees

Members: \$10 for one entry, \$15 for two, \$20 for three.

Non-Members: \$15.00 for one entry, \$20.00 for two, \$25 for three. Payments can be made by cash or check (made out to SDAG). No credit cards.

Sale of Art

All work must be for sale. A 15% commission will be collected on all work sold. An additional 5% will be collected on all credit card sales. The Off Track Gallery collects sales tax from the buyer. Artists will be notified by phone upon the sale of their work. The artist may hang another piece of eligible work to replace sold art. Payment to the artist for sold pieces will arrive in the mail approximately one month following the sale.

Description of Show Categories

Oil and Acrylic

Oil, Acrylic, Casein, or combination of oil and acrylic on canvas, Masonite, or wood

Water Media under Glass/Plexi

Any water medium on paper or illustration board which is framed under Plesi or glass. Watercolor, acrylics, casein, and gouache

Photography

Black & White, Color, Digital Prints (unmanipulated), and Polaroid Transfer

Mixed Media

Two or more medias together, such as pastel and watercolor OR one media on a built up surjace, such as watercolor on rice paper collage surface OR collage in more than one media

Other Media

Pastel (oil pastel or regular pastels).

Drawings. (Conte. graphite, charcoal, pen and ink. marker, watercolor pencils or crayons, colored pencil).

Sculpture. (ceramic, glass, metal, wood, plastic, paper-maché, bas-relief, or any other 3-D piece. Can be combined media 3-D sculpture and DOES NOT go under mixed media category).

Printmaking, Must be original and not series of prints. (Linoleum block, wood block, collograph, etching, or monoprints.). Collage (In one media) If more than one media enter in m/m. Encaustic.

Copper Enameling (no jewelry).

Ungital Art (art that is created on the computer).

Digitally Manipulated Photography (one or more photographs which have been manipulated with the use of the computer)
