





We've had to make some difficult decisions on the future for our

guild/gallery, but now, we can relax and enjoy the fruit of those choices. Please read the history of the guild and note that we are part of a long line of dedicated artists that enjoy interacting and displaying our artwork. We are thankful for everyone's participation in the past that has helped us grow. A very short history of the San Dieguito Art Guild

The Guild was organized in 1965 (some records say 1964) by a group of twelve enthusiastic artists who lived in the San Dieguito area (Del Mar to Leucadia). The Guild artists began showing their work on the lawn of the Old Del Mar Hotel property. With the money raised from the outdoor shows, commissions from sales and dues, the members were able to rent a small shop in downlown Del Mar II was named the Blue Lantern Art Gallery after the blue lantern that hung in front

of the shop. In December 1966, the Guild moved across the street to the former St. James Catholic Church, which is now the Del Mar Library. In 1969 the Guild moved again to the "I loneymoon Cottage" of the Old Del Mar Hotel. The four bedrooms were converted into art studios, the second floor became a large workshop and meeting room. The main gallery was on the ground floor. There was even room for the permanent hosts to live on sitel By 1971 they moved again. In 1975, the Guild left Del Mar and moved to Leucadia. The Guild was located in two other locations before moving to the historic Santa Fe Railroad Station in September 1994, in 2005 the Guild moved to the comer of Leucadia Blvd, and Coast Highway, In 2006 the Gallery moved again to the present (and need we say temporary location) in downtown Encinitas If Guild history is of interest to you, there are binders in the Gallery office just full of photos from years past. We are forever grateful to the previous guild members who have created the solid foundation that we enjoy lockay
