Rules for Monthly Take-in

These instructions are for the monthly wall art only.

- The art changes each month. When you come to the Gallery on **Mon. Oct. 29, 3-8 pm, Tues. Oct. 30, 2007 9:30am-12 noon**, for take in please have your temporary take in tag and take in sheet (PDF file sent along with *The Paint Rag* or inserted into your *Paint Rag* if mailed to you) filled out.
- Three pieces of artwork are allowed if space permits.
- Your work should have some identification on the back.
- Do not bring in wet paintings or frames. Giclee's are acceptable as long as they are well marked, but will not be included in the judging.
- A 15% commission will be charged on sales from the monthly wall art, plus a 5.4% credit card fee if a credit card is used.
- Work must be framed unless you use the wrap-around canvas stapled in the back.
- The wire should be the multi-strand wire (not the saw-toothed hanger typical of ready-made frames) attached approximately one-fourth of the way down from the top of the frame, and slack enough to come up to approximately 2" from the top of the frame.
- Please tape the ends of the wire, and please don't put tape or tubing in the middle of the wire.
- **If your work, including frame, measures under 17" on the diagonal the fee is \$5.00, 17" to 36" on the diagonal, including the frame the fee is \$10.00. If your work, including frame, measures over 36" on the diagonal, your fee is \$15.00. Measure carefully. Artists may show 1 or 2 or 3 pieces depending on available gallery wall space.**
- Be sure your work looks as nice as it can, with clean, well put-together frame, clean glass and a well-cut mat.
- The Take-in committee reserves the right to refuse entries that do not meet gallery standards.

Shrink Wrap Bin

Doreen Long is in charge of monitoring the shrink wrap bin. The rules are as follows:

- Membership dues must be current or your art will be removed
 - Foam Core or matte board backers (no cardboard) to art work
 - Number allowed: 2 large and 5 small (small is 12 inches or under on the longest size)
 - Clean mats
 - Clean poly bags
 - All prints of original art work (such as Gicleés) must be clearly marked as "PRINT" or "REPRODUCTION"
 - All shrink wraps to be on listed on filing cards in box located in gallery office
- We suggest you rotate your art every couple of months to keep the art in the bin "fresh"

- ❖ Commission for work sold is only 15%. The Off Track collects necessary sales taxes.

Eligibility

- Open to all Southern California artists.
- All work must be the original work of the artist.
- You may put in reproductions (such as Gicleés) and offer them for sale, but they are NOT eligible for prize money or ribbons.
- All work must be for sale.

Five Show Categories

- Oil and Acrylic
- Water Media under Glass or Plexi
- Photography
- Mixed Media
- Other Media

Entry Rules

- Maximum entry size for flat work is 12” square, **including the frame**, 12” cubed for sculpture and 3-D work.
- Three entries maximum per artist.
- Oils must be dry. Do not bring in wet paintings.
- Works paper must be under glass or Plexi.
- All 2D works must have a multi-strand wire (not one of those saw-toothed hangers that usually come with ready-made frames) attached securely approx. 1/4 of the way down from the top of the frame and slack enough to come up to approx.. 2 inches from the top of the frame. Ends of wire must be taped. Other hanging devices will be rejected. This is strictly enforced.
- The Committee may reject any entry deemed inappropriate.
- Work may not be withdrawn until the end of the show.
- Work must be framed unless you use wrap-around canvas stapled on the back (no staples on sides).
- Be sure your work looks as nice as it can, with clean, well put-together frame, clean glass and clean well-cut mat.
- The Guild reserves the right to refuse entries that do not meet SDAG standards.
- Reproductions/prints of original art (such as Gicleés) must CLEARLY be identified as such (and will not be judged or awarded prize money or ribbons).
- Calligraphy as part of the art piece is acceptable.

Entry Fees

Members: \$10 for one entry, \$15 for two, \$20 for three.

Non-Members: \$15.00 for one entry, \$20.00 for two, \$25 for three. Payments can be made by cash or check (made out to SDAG). No credit cards.

Sale of Art

All work must be for sale. A 15% commission will be collected on all work sold. An additional 5% will be collected on all credit card sales. The Off Track Gallery collects sales tax from the buyer. Artists will be notified by phone upon the sale of their work. The artist may hang another piece of eligible work to replace sold art. Payment to the artist for sold pieces will arrive in the mail approximately one month following the sale.

Description of Show Categories

Oil and Acrylic

Oil, Acrylic, Casein, or combination of oil and acrylic on canvas, Masonite, or wood

Water Media under Glass/Plexi

Any water medium on paper or illustration board which is framed under Plexi or glass. Watercolor, acrylics, casein, and gouache

Photography

Black & White, Color, Digital Prints (unmanipulated), and Polaroid Transfer

Mixed Media

Two or more medias together, such as pastel and watercolor OR one media on a built up surface, such as watercolor on rice paper collage surface OR collage in more than one media

Other Media

Pastel. (oil pastel or regular pastels).

Drawings. (Conte, graphite, charcoal, pen and ink, marker, watercolor pencils or crayons, colored pencil).

Sculpture. (ceramic, glass, metal, wood, plastic, paper-maché, bas-relief, or any other 3-D piece. Can be combined media 3-D sculpture and DOES NOT go under mixed media category).

Printmaking. Must be original and not series of prints. (Linoleum block, wood block, collograph, etching, or monoprints.). Collage (In one media) If more than one media enter in m/m.

Encaustic.

Copper Enameling (no jewelry unless in enclosed frame on wall).

Digital Art (art that is created on the computer).

Digitally-Manipulated Photography (one or more photographs which have been manipulated with the use of the computer)
